## **Key Terms**



#### Cohort

A specific group of students established for tracking purposes. This cohort includes all full-time, first-time, degree seeking students who enter the fall term of a given academic year.



#### **Graduation Rate**

This rate is calculated as the total number of completers within the federal 150% of normal timeframe divided by the cohort.



# Normal time to completion

The amount of time necessary for a student to complete all requirements for a degree or certificate according to the institution's catalog.

The 150% of the time for associate degrees is 3.5 years, for 4-year baccalaureates is 6 years and for 5-year baccalaureates is 7.5 years.
