By the academics years 2007-2008 and 2008-2009 the College of Arts and Sciences expects to begin PhD programs in Biology, Physics, Biotechnology, Humanistic Studies and Cultural Theories and a School of Psychology. There are also plans to begin a Master program in Kinesiology, a Bachelor program in Atmospheric Sciences and Meteorology and a Minor in Meteorology. In the College of Engineering a proposal for the PhD program in Electrical Engineering is under revision by the University Administration. Proposals for a Doctoral program in Mechanical Engineering are also underway. A new curriculum revision for the Mechanical Engineering undergraduate program in which Minors in Aerospace, Manufacturing and Biomedical areas are to be integrated. By the academic year 2008-2009 the College of Agricultural Sciences should have developed and submitted a new undergraduate curriculum in Natural Resources Management and a new interdisciplinary undergraduate curriculum in Food Science and Technology. They also expect to begin a PhD program in Tropical Agriculture with specializations in Animal Science, Plant Protection, Plant Breeding, and Soil and Water Resources. They are working to consolidate the Agronomy and Soils departments and the Horticulture and Crop Sciences departments. The College of Business Administration is continuing the revision of the curriculum for the Bachelor of Science in Business Administration Degree and also for the MBA program. These revisions contemplate a reduction in the required credits for graduation, innovative courses for all areas and will provide better curricular flexibility. As of this semester, the Marketing

specialization in the MBA program has been put in a moratorium status. The Faculty should have obtained AACSB accreditation by academic year 2008-2009.
